Water Temperature/Thermometer Calibration Chart

1. Responsible person: The facility supervisor or their designee/AFL Provider.
2. Check water temperature **monthly** at each hot water outlet.
3. Calibrate thermometer prior to testing water temperature.
4. To calibrate the thermometer, place thermometer in ice water and allow to sit 3 – 5 minutes. If the thermometer doesn't register 32 degrees Fahrenheit, then allow for difference when determining temperature.
5. The hot water temperature must register between 100 and 116 degrees Fahrenheit.
6. Report any problems/concerns encountered (AFLs take action to correct any problems).
7. Day Programs - file in facility Safety Notebook / AFLs – file with monthly paperwork.
